

# NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given, that on Tuesday, the 12th of May, 2026, at the usual polling places in the precincts of Gage County, Nebraska, an election will be held. The polls will open at 8:00 o'clock a.m. and close at 8:00 o'clock p.m. Said election will be nominating, or in some cases electing, candidates to various offices. At such election voters may accept or reject statewide constitutional amendments or referendums. The Secretary of State will publish a true copy of the title and text of any amendments or referendums once each week for three consecutive weeks preceding the election.
