

The Gage County Board of Supervisors met on March 8, 2023, at 8:47 a.m. with Terry Jurgens, Emily Haxby, Erich Tiemann, Eddie Dorn, Dave Swavely and Gary Lytle present, Don Schuller absent.

Notice of said meeting was posted at the County Clerk's Office and published prior to the meeting in compliance with State Statutes.

Let the record show that all proceedings are electronically recorded.

Pledge of Allegiance recited.

Chairman Tiemann announced that a complete copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted at the back of the Board of Supervisors Room.

Consent Agenda included the following items: 1. General Agenda; 2. Minutes from previous meeting and committee meetings; 3. claims audit in the amount of \$2,579,159.72 except claim #23030066 to R. L. Tiemann, Const. in the amount of \$21,533.06 to be voted on separately below; 4. approve correspondence received and place on file; 5. approve District Court Summary Fee Report & Register of Deeds Fee Report for the month of February, 2023; 6. approve Utility Permit #1268 to Windstream Nebraska LLC. Windstream will be replacing a service line to residence at 3040 Dogwood Road. Windstream will bore a 2" by 60" line for the new service line from pedestal 153QJ located in the South grader ditch, bore under Dogwood Road to North grader ditch and then continue the bore on private property. Located on the North side of Section 31 and South side of Section 30, T-5-N, R-7-E, Hanover Twp; 7. approve Utility Permit #1269 to Lower Big Blue NRD. NRD will be installing a new water line to residence at 25194 SW 45th Road. The NRD will bore a 6" by 72" line for the new water line starting in the West grader ditch, bore under SW 45th Road to East grader ditch and then continue the bore on private Section of 29, T-4-N, R-6-E, Midland Twp.

Motion made by Swavely, seconded by Dorn to approve the consent agenda. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion made by Jurgens, seconded by Swavely to approve claim #23030066 to R. L. Tiemann, Const. in the amount of \$21,533.06. This brings the total amount of claims approved thru March 8, 2023 to \$2,600,692.78. Motion carried 5-0-1 with Tiemann abstaining due to conflict of interest.

Monte Murkle, 7001 W. Aspen Rd., Clatonia, NE spoke under public comments. He brought a sign to show the board what would be placed in the lawn on March 21st (as previously approved the year before) and discussed the lenses for the lights on the courthouse in order to recognize World Down Syndrome Day, and thanked the board.

Committee reports were given by Swavely on Building & Grounds; Finance/Insurance by Jurgens & Law Enf/Emer. Mgmt. by Lytle, Millard & Lisa; Road & Bridge by Haxby. Items discussed included discussion with architects, P&Z meeting & Special Use permit, vehicles sold on purple wave and the final payment to Beatrice 6.

Erich spoke on the long road to paying the Beatrice 6 Judgment and thanked all that assisted in getting us to this point. Haxby thanked those involved even when outside individuals were questioning all their decisions. Lytle stated that he appreciated all the work that has gone into getting to this point, he didn't know whether to celebrate or cry.

Motion made by Jurgens, seconded by Lytle to accept all rock & gravel bids which were presented at the last meeting. Motion carried 5-0-1 with Tiemann abstaining due to conflict of interest.

Discussion took place on a county IT vendor. A number of companies had been explored. It is not just IT services that the county is looking for in a vendor, but also the Cyber Security and media/security issues among a few items.

Motion made by Haxby, seconded by Jurgens to approve Applied Connective for IT/Cyber Security services and negotiating a contract with said company. Motion carried 6-0.

Short break at 9:49 a.m. Reconvened meeting at 9:54 a.m.

Motion made by Dorn, seconded by Swavely to go into closed session at 9:54 a.m. for personnel. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion made by Dorn, seconded by Haxby to move out of closed session at 10:57 a.m. Motion carried 5-0, with Jurgens out during closed session.

Motion made by Swavely, seconded by Haxby to adjourn meeting at 10:57 a.m. Motion carried 5-0.

Chairman declared Board of Supervisors meeting adjourned at 10:57 a.m. until March 22, 2023.
