Steve Janssen, 13005 E Locust Rd., Virginia, NE spoke under public comments regarding the condition of 162<sup>nd</sup> Road. He said the road was narrowed up and that his son went into ditch. He would like to see the road hard surfaced.

Committee reports were given by Swavely on Bldg. & Grounds/Winter Lights, Tiemann on Equalization, Jurgens on Finance/Insurance, Tiemann on Human Resources/Employee Relations, Lytle on Law Enforcement, Lisa W. on Emergency Management, and Jurgens, Tiemann and Haxby on Road & Bridge. Items of discussion were meetings with architects, public hearings for Special Use Permits, a bridge by Barneston, progress of the broadband project and the need for help from the community, and a meeting with the Gage County Broadband Outreach Group at 402 in the back room on March 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m., for those that want an update on the Broadband project or to assist with other projects pertaining to the Broadband.

Planning & Zoning Administrator Lisa Wiegand gave the P&Z Commission's recommendation on Special Use Permit #2023-1 for a greenhouse, saying that one concern with the owner was the use of herbicides by surrounding farmers but that he had spoken to them about it. The P&Z's recommendation was to approve the Special Use Permit.

Motion made by Dorn, seconded by Swavely to open public hearing at 9:15 a.m. to hear support and/or opposition on Special Use Permit #2023-1 for the placement of a commercial greenhouse operation to be placed in the SE ¼ of Section 28 in Logan Township. Motion carried 7-0.

Speaking in support of the permit was Ashley Mason, 1300 Lincoln St., Beatrice NE. Applicant Eric Jobman, 6509 E Hoyt Rd., Beatrice NE, said the permit is for a commercial greenhouse to grow products to sell to the community.

Speaking at the public hearing were: Tracy Zimmerman, 32741 S 162<sup>nd</sup> Rd., Virginia NE; Lenhart Fritzen, 29813 S 120<sup>th</sup> Rd., Beatrice NE; Steve Janssen, 13005 E Locust Rd., Virginia NE; Steve Knoche, 28827 S 176<sup>th</sup> Rd., Virginia NE; and Rick Clabaugh, 326 Morton Dr., Beatrice. Discussion included grants being pursued to improve 162<sup>nd</sup> Rd. and would like some help from the county; encouragement to approve the 1 & 6 and making it a priority; the cost to armor coat a mile (Tiemann estimated \$15,000); the difference in price of concrete vs asphalt; getting caught up on rock and gravel allocations; funeral traffic to cemetery in Sherman Twp.; S 134<sup>th</sup> Rd between Lilac and Linden roads and discussions about county taking it over but would leave it as a township road; Linden Rd. is bad apple with muddy patches, needs to be resurfaced, should make it a priority on 1 & 6; SENDD spoke at Virginia Village meeting and informed them of a grant through Sen. Fischer's Office which they did apply for, local realtor looking at 4-5 lots with the possibility of building houses, Village is excited for what can develop in the village.

Haxby spoke about 2 projects missing on the 1 & 6 plan which are the Buss River Bridge replacement on Dogwood Rd., proj. C34-12405, and mill & overlays of Christ Lutheran Church blacktop between S 25<sup>th</sup> Rd. and Hwy 41, and Pickrell East blacktop.
