

The Gage County Board of Supervisors met on July 9, 2025, at 8:45 a.m. as per public notice given on the county website and in the Beatrice Daily Sun on June 26, 2025, copy of the proof of publication being on file in the County Clerk's Office. The agenda for all meetings is kept continually current and is available for public inspection at the County Clerk's Office during normal business hours and was communicated in the advance notice of the meeting. The Board of Supervisors has the right to modify the agenda to include items of an emergency nature only, at such public meeting. All of the proceedings shown hereafter were taken while in the convened meeting which was open to the attendance of the public.

Supervisors Rex Adams, Rick Clabaugh, Emily Haxby, Erich Tiemann, Gary Lytle, Eddie Dorn, and Terry Jurgens present.

Chairman Tiemann announced that a complete copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted at the back of the Board of Supervisors Room.

Motion by Dorn, seconded by Clabaugh to approve claim #25070079 to R.L. Tiemann, Const. Inc. in the amount of \$56,807.21, bringing the total amount of claims paid through July 9, 2025, to \$1,187,753.16. Motion carried 6-0-1 with Tiemann abstaining due to conflict of interest.

Motion by Lytle, seconded by Dorn to approve Visitors Improvement Fund Grant request from Carnegie Center Inc. for wood floor replacement in the amount of \$7,764.00. Motion carried 7-0.

The board thanked Harriet VanEngen for her 12+ years of service on the Tourism Advisory Committee as she resigned effective June 30, 2025.

Motion by Dorn, seconded by Lytle to approve appointing Jeannette Dorn to replace Harriet VanEngen on the Tourism Advisory Committee. Her term is effective 7/1/2025. Motion carried 7-0.

Don Esau spoke to the board regarding the upcoming Gage County Fair.

Motion by Lytle, seconded by Dorn to approve recommendation for four Special Designated liquor licenses for Gage County Ag Society, one for Gage County Fairgrounds beer garden on the Midway for the Gage County Fair, July 23-26, 2025, one for the Bull Riding Rodeo at the Horse Arena, July 23, 2025, and one for the track area for the Concert in the Grandstand on July 25, 2025. The fourth is for an alternate location of the lower (old) horse arena in case of inclement weather for either the Bull Riding on July 23rd or the Concert on July 25<sup>th</sup>.
