Marcella Rademacher, 9247 S 96^{th} Rd., Adams NE, spoke under public comments regarding property valuation protest.

Committee reports were given by Dave Jones on Bldg. & Grounds; Tiemann on Equalization and Human Resources/Employee Relations; Jurgens on Finance/Insurance; Lytle & Lisa Wiegand on Law Enforcement/Emergency Management; and Haxby on Road & Bridge. Topics included second door for first floor; LED light installation by Plymouth Electric is almost complete; panic buttons installed; solar project; grant writer; cost of ice control material; and bridge match program. Jurgens commented that we probably have the best grant writer in the state (Haxby) as she has brought in thousands and thousands of dollars to the county through grants.

Tom Bliss, Executive Director of Southeast Nebraska Development District (SENDD), presented an update of SENDD activities. He also introduced new employee Amanda North, and Housing Inspector Brent Pendgraft. They talked about home buying programs, CDBG projects, and buying homes for renovation to be put on the market at affordable prices. They stressed that they are fortunate to have Tiemann and Haxby to work with on different projects.

Tom Bliss discussed the importance of an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between SENDD and Gage County, giving SENDD the much-needed ability to own property.

Motion by Lytle, seconded by Jurgens to approve Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with SENDD. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Lytle, seconded by Clabaugh to approve an RFP (Request for Proposals) for a Grant Writer for the county. Motion carried 7-0.

Jurgens left meeting at 9:56 a.m.
